## Duties

Under general direction of the State Services Manager I (SSM I), Facilities Operations Section, the Maintenance Mechanic independently performs a variety of skilled work. Duties include, but are not limited to:

- Inspects, maintains, and repairs plumbing, heating and cooling, water and sewer systems
- Performs electrical maintenance and repair work
- Inspects and certifies backflow devices
- Inspects, maintains and patches roofs as needed
- Repairs doors, door hardware, locks, windows, and Venetian blinds
- Adjusts shelves, cabinets and cabinet lighting
- Repairs holes in warehouse concrete floors
- Replaces or repairs ceiling tiles
- Requisitions supplies needed in maintaining and repairing Lottery buildings
- Estimates labor requirements and costs for purchases and repairs
- Investigates reports of damage, inspects buildings and grounds, and takes necessary action to make repairs

## Desirable Qualifications

Competitive applicants applying for this position will have:

- Possess EPA Class 1 and Class 3 HVAC certification and be certified as a Backflow Prevention Assembly Tester and Underground Storage Tank Operator
- Bilingual Skills are desirable, but not required

## Who Should Apply

Candidates eligible for Post & Bid include employees who have permanent full-time status as a Warehouse Worker and who possess the required skills and abilities. To apply for Post & Bid, submit a standard State application (STD 678) form and a departmental bid request form. The position will be awarded to the Post & Bid candidate with the highest seniority. If no Post & Bid candidates apply, selection will be opened to those candidates who have current list eligibility for appointment to this class, or be a State employee who has transfer eligibility, or is currently in the Warehouse Worker classification. Applications will be screened and only those that best meet the requirements of the job will be considered. Appointment is subject to the provisions of SROA/Surplus. Prior to appointment, candidate must possess a valid Class C California driver license (formerly known as Class 3).
