

# California Lottery Mission Education Campaign January 2024



### Background

CA Lottery's Public Affairs and Communications (PAC) team is responsible for raising awareness of the Lottery's mission to contribute supplemental funding for public education.

### ∧ Californians are largely unaware

of Lottery's purpose to benefit public schools and often misunderstand its operations.

- Past efforts have been somewhat limited to Lottery owned channels and through earned media.
- The Lottery launches a new campaign

to reach a broader audience across more platforms, showcasing the real impacts Lottery funds have on public school programs.




