\$1.3 Million Powerball® Winning Ticket Sold in Yuba City

Next Powerball Jackpot Worth an Astonishing \$620 Million!

SACRAMENTO – One California Lottery player is closing out September by winning \$1,361,359 in last night's *Powerball* drawing.

The ticket, which matched five of the six numbers, was sold at 7-Eleven located at 1605 Butte House Road in Yuba City (Sutter County). That retailer will receive a bonus of \$6,806 for selling the winning ticket.

The ticket matched the numbers 32-17-2-7-11 but missed the Powerball number 11.

No one won the *Powerball* jackpot last night, meaning the jackpot for this coming Saturday night's drawing is estimated at an impressive **\$620 million**!

The California Lottery raises supplemental funding for the state's public schools, colleges, and universities. The Lottery also provides essential revenue to more than 23,000 local businesses that sell tickets. This money directly helps local businesses – most of which are independently owned.

The California Lottery's mission is to provide supplemental funding to California public schools, including kindergarten and grades 1-12, community colleges, the California State University, the University of California, and other California public educational entities. The funds the Lottery transferred to public education totaled approximately\$1.5 billion for fiscal year 2019-20, which amounted to a modest percentage of education's overall budget. However, this funding is largely nondiscretionary, meaning schools can use this for important, yet unfunded instructional programs they would otherwise not afford. During the same period, the Lottery generated almost \$7 billion in sales, more than 95% of which went back to the community in the form of prize payments, retailer commissions and bonuses, and contributions to education.
