That lucky ticket was sold at L & M Liquor in Hayward, which now gets a bonus of \$100,000 just for selling it.

Seven other lucky Scratchers tickets are also bringing holiday cheer to California Lottery players around the state.

- **Teresa Martinez** pocketed \$5,000,000 on a *100X* Scratchers ticket bought at Golden Eagle Gas in Morgan Hill.
- The team effort of **Eric Holtzman** and **Matoux De La Croix** won \$5,000,000 on a *Premier 7's* game from the CVS Pharmacy in Porter Ranch (Los Angeles County).

- **German Medina Zapata** won big on that game as well, bringing home \$5,000,000 on a *Premier 7's* bought at K&H Liquors in San Francisco. The next winner played a game that lived up to its name; **Roberto Perez** struck gold with a \$1,000,000 win on a \$1,000,000 California Riches Scratchers bought at Hanshaw Liquor in Garden Grove.
- **Maribel Delos Reyes** also joins the ranks of million-dollar winners with a win of \$1,000,000 on an *Ice Cool* Scratchers from Terry's Liquor in Artesia (Los Angeles County).
- Miesha Dumas also secured \$1,000,000 on an *Ice Cool* Scratchers bought at the 7-Eleven on Carson Street in Lakewood (Los Angeles County).
- Rounding out the latest millionaires the California Lottery is unveiling today, Teh-An Lin soared to a \$1,000,000 windfall on a Cloud 9 Scratchers bought at Seafood City in Hayward.

The California Lottery's mission is to provide supplemental funding to California public schools, including kindergarten and grades 1-12, community colleges, the California State University, the University of California, and other California public educational entities. The funds the Lottery transferred to public education totaled more than \$2.07 billion for fiscal year 2021-22, which amounted to a modest percentage of education's overall budget. However, this funding is largely discretionary, meaning schools can use this for important, yet unfunded instructional programs they would otherwise not afford. During the same period, the Lottery generated more than \$8.85 billion in sales, more than 95% of which went back to the community in the form of prize payments, retailer commissions and bonuses, and contributions to education.
