Powerball® Ticket Worth \$1.8+ Million Sold in Southern California

SACRAMENTO – Nobody hit the Powerball jackpot in Saturday night’s drawing, but one lucky ticket sold in San Diego County matched 5 numbers and is now worth \$1,801,715! Someone bought that winning ticket at the Shell gas station on Eastlake Parkway in Chula Vista. The winning numbers were 8-21-31-32-37 and Powerball 23.

With nine ways to earn a prize, there were more than 54,000 [winning Powerball tickets](#) sold in California for Saturday’s draw. Players can use the official California Lottery app to check their ticket and find out if it’s a winner. The odds of hitting the jackpot are one in about 292,000,000, but the odds of winning at *any prize level* are just one in 24.

Because no one matched all six numbers Saturday, the jackpot for Monday’s draw rolls to an estimated \$87 million.

Powerball is played three nights a week: Mondays, Wednesdays, and Saturdays. Draws happen at 7:59pm PT.

The California Lottery’s mission is to provide supplemental funding to California public schools, including kindergarten and grades 1-12, community colleges, the California State University, the University of California, and other California public educational entities.
