The Lottery continues to ensure responsible gaming outreach is part of its daily operations and communications through social media, the Lottery website, and the "Play Responsibly" messaging printed on the back of every Scratchers® ticket (see image below).

These efforts to support Problem Gambling Awareness Month are a significant part of the California Lottery's responsible gaming program which has received international recognition with the highest certification (Level 4) from the <u>World Lottery Association</u>.

The California Lottery's mission is to provide supplemental funding to California public schools, including kindergarten and grades 1-12, community colleges, the California State University, the University of California, and other California public educational entities. The funds the Lottery transferred to public education totaled more than \$1.88 billion for fiscal year 2020-21, which amounted to a modest percentage of education's overall budget. However, this funding is largely discretionary, meaning schools can use this for important, yet unfunded instructional programs they would otherwise not afford. During the same period, the Lottery generated almost \$8.4 billion in sales, more than 95% of which went back to the community in the form of prize payments, retailer commissions and bonuses, and contributions to education.
