## *Tonight's \$1.09 Billion Powerball® Jackpot Among Top Ten Highest Jackpots on Record*

**SACRAMENTO** – With an estimated \$1.09 billion jackpot up for grabs in tonight's *Powerball* drawing, this marks the second consecutive week California Lottery players have had a shot at a billion bucks. Last week, however, it was a player in another state who won \$1.128 billion in the *Mega Millions*® drawing. Will it happen in the Golden State tonight?

Tonight's prize ranks as the fourth-largest <u>Powerball jackpot</u> and ninth-largest U.S. lottery jackpot, placing it just one ranking below that big win in New Jersey last Tuesday.

## Record U.S. Lottery Jackpots

Tonight's jackpot has been growing for more than three months now, and in that time, California Lottery estimates it's been able to raise an **additional approximately \$80 million for public education** just from *Powerball* sales alone. Raising additional, supplemental funding for public schools is the <u>sole mission of the California Lottery</u>.

If one person wins tonight's top prize, they'll have the choice of taking the final jackpot total in 30 annual payments, or they can take the lump sum cash value, which is currently estimated to be \$527.3.8 million. Tonight's <u>*Powerball*</u> drawing happens at 7:59pm PT, and anyone hoping to win tonight has to buy their tickets by 7pm at one of the more than <u>23,000 California Lottery retail partner</u> <u>locations</u>.

The mission of the California Lottery is to raise additional funding for public education, helping to supplement school budgets for K-12 as well as colleges and universities. **The California Lottery has raised more than \$43.8 billion for public schools** through the responsible sale of its games since 1985. Lottery funding for schools is largely discretionary, so administrators and educators can use Lottery money for instructional programs and services they may not otherwise afford. The California Lottery features eight <u>draw games</u> and dozens of new instant <u>Scratchers</u> games each year. More than 95% of California Lottery sales revenue goes back to the community in the form of prize payments, <u>retailer commissions and bonuses</u>, and contributions to education.
