 A Winning Combination for California SchoolsSACRAMENTO - The Mega Millions® jackpot is now closing in on $\$ 800$ million after no one hit it Tuesday night. Today, though, all eyes will be on the other giant jackpot up for grabs Powerbal/® - now offering an estimated $\$ 559$ million top prize in the drawing this evening.

Tonight's will be the $31^{\text {st }}$ Powerball drawing in the current jackpot run, which began more than two months ago. If only one person hits the jackpot tonight, they'll have the option of taking an estimated $\$ 273.3$ million cash prize or the final jackpot total over 30 annual payments.

Whether there's a jackpot winner tonight or not - and no matter where the jackpot is hit California schools are benefitting nicely from these climbing prize pots. Combined sales related to these dueling jackpot runs have helped the California Lottery raise nearly $\$ 95$ million for public education so far - just from these games alone. That figure will continue to climb throughout the day and week as Mega Millions and Powerball sales continue to soar.
"Every dollar counts when it comes to public education," said Carolyn Becker, California Lottery spokesperson. "The California Lottery is proud to support public schools; it's our sole mission and the only reason we exist. When we see jackpots climb this high, we take even more pride in our work, knowing schools are reaping the rewards as well as any winners."

Mega Millions and Powerball tickets are $\$ 2$ each, and from every ticket sold in California, about 80 cents helps schools. Tonight's Powerball drawing happens at 7:59pm PT, and anyone hoping to win tonight has to buy their ticket by 7 pm at any of the more than 23,000 California Lottery retail locations throughout the state.
