## Mega Millions® and Powerbal/® Now Offering Combined Jackpots of \$1.1+ Billion

And Another California Lottery Player Becomes a Millionaire!

SACRAMENTO - Tonight's Mega Millions jackpot offers players the chance at an estimated $\$ 650$ million, and with the Powerball® jackpot rolling Monday night to a now estimated $\$ 485$ million - California Lottery players have more than a billion reasons to buy a ticket right now.

California Lottery player Huong Vu took a chance on Powerball for a drawing this past October. She wound up winning more than a million dollars after recently claiming her prize. Vu's ticket came from Town \& Country Market in San Francisco and missed winning more than a billion dollars by just one number.

If someone becomes the only player to win tonight's Mega Millions jackpot, they'll have the option of taking either the final top prize total in 30 annual payments or the cash value lump sum payment, currently estimated at nearly $\$ 308.6$ million before federal taxes.

The California Lottery estimates it has raised an additional $\$ 48.8$ million for public education just from Mega Millions sales in the past three months. That's when the game's top prize began at $\$ 20$ million and has been growing ever since with no jackpot winner. Generating additional money for public schools is the sole mission of the California Lottery.

Mega Millions tickets are $\$ 2$ each, and approximately 80 cents of every ticket sold in California goes to schools. Players can buy tickets for tonight's draw up until 7:45 p.m. at any of the California Lottery's more than 23,000 retail partner locations. The draw happens at 8 p.m.
