



While TX had the highest Instant Ticket Sales in FY 2023-24, CA is tops in Q2 of FY 2024-25

- In Q1, CA was also first with TX in 2nd place.
- In Q2, FL passed TX for 2nd.
- In Q2, CA's Scratchers sales grew by 5% from the prior year's Q2. Our growth was larger than FL (+4%) and TX (+3%)



MM Jackpot of \$1.2 billion in Q2 helped Draw Games Sales increase over Q1 particularly in CA

- With the big Mega Millions jackpot in December 2024, Draw Game sales in Fall 2024 were higher than during the summer.
- CA experienced larger gains at 13% compared to FL (+8%), MA (+5%), and NY & MI (+4%)
- The other top selling states have other Draw Games providing consistently strong sales throughout the year.

Other Industry Rankings for Q2

In addition to being #2 in Total Lottery sales, and #1 for Scratchers sales, CA was also.....

- #1 state for Mega Millions sales
- #1 state for Powerball sales
- However, CA was #6 for Monitor Games sales with Massachusetts having the most sales in this category

First Six Months of FY: FL Narrowly in 1st Place

- Adding together Summer (Q1) and Fall (Q2) sales for this FY results in FL having the highest Total Sales among U. S. lotteries with CA being just \$13 million short of first place:
 - FL: \$4.490 billion
 - CA: \$4.477 billion
 - TX: \$4.112 billion
 - NY: \$3.946 billion
 - MA: \$2.970 billion
 - GA: \$2.577 billion
- For the full fiscal year 2023-24, CA trailed FL for highest Total Sales by \$133 million
