Mamikon Zakaryan also joined the multimillionaire club with a \$2,000,000 win from an *Instant Prize Crossword* Scratchers bought at Dales Jr. Liquors in Hollywood.

Jose Lopez also won \$2,000,000 with *Instant Prize Crossword*. His ticket came from T Mart in Castroville.

Foad Ishak completes the list of new \$2,000,000 *Instant Prize Crossword* winners. That ticket came from Copper Lamp Liquor in Monrovia.



Meanwhile, **Aurelio Chayrez** claimed a \$1,000,000 prize with an *Ice Cool* Scratchers from the Chevron on South Tracy Boulevard in Tracy.

Rounding out this incredible run of luck, **Salvador Zarate** claimed a \$1,000,000 prize with a *\$1 Million Ultimate Cash!* Scratchers game, which came from the Quick Stop in Freedom.
