Jackpot! One Lucky SuperLotto Plus® Player Just Lit Up Their Weekend

Ticket Worth \$25 Million Sold in Riverside County

SACRAMENTO – One California Lottery ticket for *SuperLotto Plus* is worth \$25 million this morning after one player matched all six numbers in the Saturday, May 10 drawing. The winning ticket came from the USA Tobacco shop at 2743 Hamner Avenue in Norco.

The winning numbers were 7, 10, 11, 21, 32 and 5. The jackpot winner won't be alone in their super weekend celebration. The retailer also gets a \$125,000 bonus for selling the jackpot-winning ticket. There was also a 5-number match sold in Agoura Hills by the 76 Station at 30245 Canwood Street. That ticket is worth \$33,650.

SuperLotto Plus is California's original millionaire-maker and can only be played in the Golden State. The California Lottery won't know who Saturday night's big winner is until they come forward and does not announce the names of winners until after they've been vetted by law enforcement, declared the rightful winner, and received their official prize payment.

SuperLotto Plus jackpot winners have 180 days from the date of the drawing to claim their prize, making the deadline for this prize November 6, 2025. Claim forms are available on the [California Lottery website](https://www.calottery.com). Players can also pick up a claim form at any of the more than 23,000 California Lottery [retail partner locations](#).

Just \$1 to play, every *SuperLotto Plus* ticket sold generates approximately 40 cents for public schools.
